Recycling Your Cleargard[®] – Movena Laminated Safety Glass

As part of our environmental commitment and in accordance with ISO 14001 principles, we would like to inform you of the best practices for managing and recycling your old windshield.

1. Why recycle your old windshield?

A laminated windshield contains:

- Glass, recyclable at over 90%
- PVB interlayer that can be recovered
- ometimes plastics or metal components

Recycling helps to:

- Reduce non-recyclable waste
- Preserve natural resources
- Limit pollution related to composite materials

2. What should you do with your old windshield?

As we do not collect used windshields, here are the appropriate solutions:

Option 1 :Drop off the windshield at a specialized collection point

Laminated glass cannot be disposed of in standard glass containers. You can take it to:

- A professional recycling center accepting laminated glass
- An approved recycling facility
- A service provider specialized in glass processing

These facilities are equipped to properly recycle both glass and PVB.

Option 2: Use a private service provider

Some companies offer:

- On-site collection
- Batch pickup of glazing
- Treatment and recycling of laminated glass

If you regularly handle glazing, this option may be particularly suitable.

3. What must not be done

- ✗ Do not dispose of the windshield in regular waste
- ✗ Do not place it in household glass containers (incompatible glass)
- ✗ Do not intentionally break it
- ✗ Do not leave it outdoors or in nature

Laminated glass requires specific treatment.

4. Safety handling advice

Even though the windshield remains intact thanks to the PVB interlayer, it can be heavy and sharp.

- ✓ Wear cut-resistant gloves
- ✓ Keep the glass in a vertical position
- ✓ Carry it with two people if necessary
- ✓ Avoid sudden impacts
